They will receive a Certificate of Attendance for their records.	Attendees keep a personal record of attendance for filing the Attorney's Annual Report of Compliance, Form 1, by July 31 of each year. NO certificate or other attendance evidence is submitted to the MO Bar.	Attendees need a Certificate of Completion, Activity Evaluation Form for California MCLE and they must sign the Official Record of Attendance for California MCLE form (which is left with the provider).
