



# **South Dakota Notary Commission Process**

Step-by-Step Instructions to Begin My Notary Commission

#### ☐ Step 1

I am eligible to become a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements:

- 18 years or older
- A SD resident, or nonresident from a county bordering SD and working in state
- No felony convictions

#### ☐ Step 2

I purchased my state-required Notary bond, seal stamp and supplies at NationalNotary.org/SD/Become or I called 1-800-876-6827.

## ☐ Step 3

I have received the supplies that are not dependent upon my commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc.), including my seal stamp.

#### ☐ Step 4

I have received my bond via email from the National Notary Association.

### ☐ Step 5

I completed my Notary commission application and sent it with my \$30 commission fee to:

Office of the Secretary of State Notary Public Division 500 East Capitol Avenue Pierre, SD 57501

#### ☐ Step 6

I have received my commission certificate from the state.

NOTE: Any <u>South Dakota Notary package</u> you purchase from the NNA will include your state required items: Notary bond and stamp. It's the best and most convenient way to make sure you have everything you need to become a South Dakota Notary.
