#### ☐ Step 1

I am eligible to become a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements:

- 18 years or older
- State resident physically residing in Alaska for at least 30 days with the intent to remain indefinitely; legal resident of the U.S.
- Must be able to read and write English; no felony convictions in 10 years; no commission revocation in 10 years

#### ☐ Step 2

I purchased my state-required Notary seal and supplies at <a href="www.NationalNotary.org/AK/Become">www.NationalNotary.org/AK/Become</a> or called 1-800-876-6827.

### ☐ Step 3

I have received the supplies that are not dependent upon my commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc.).

#### ☐ Step 4

I have received my bond via email to submit with my application.

#### ☐ Step 5

I have completed my commission application (https://ltgov.alaska.gov/notaries-public/commission-applications/regular-notary-commission)

#### ☐ Step 6

Wait for the state to issue and mail the commission certificate, approximately 2-3 weeks after submitting my application.

## ☐ Step 7

I will scan and email a copy of my commission certificate to <a href="Releasing@NationalNotary.org">Releasing@NationalNotary.org</a> or fax it to 1-800-833-1211 to my have notary stamp made. Once my documents have been received, my stamp will ship within 3 business days.
