 Step 1 I am eligible to become a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements: ■ 18 years or older ■ Must be able to read and write English. ■ Legal resident of DE, or a non-resident who maintains an office or regular place of employment in DE. ■ Reasonable need for commission ■ Good character and reputation; no felony convictions unless rights have been restored; no conviction involving dishonesty or moral turpitude
Step 2
I purchased my state-required Notary seal and supplies at www.NationalNotary.org/DE/Become or called 1-800-876 6827.
Step 3
I have received the supplies that are not dependent upon my commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc.).
Step 4 I have submitted my application at https://notary.delaware.gov/apply-notary-commission/
Step 5 I have received my commission certificate from the state.
Step 6
I have signed and taken my oath of office before a Notary Public. I have emailed a copy of my notarized oath to the Secretary of State at notary@delaware.gov before performing any notarial act.
Step 7
I have emailed or faxed a copy of my commission certificate with my NNA Customer ID number to Releasing@nationalnotary.org or via fax to 1-800-833-1211. Once my documents have been received, my stamp will be shipped within 3 business days.
Step 8
I have received my seal stamp and insurance.
