Step 1

I am eligible to become a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements:

- **18 years or older**
- **Reside in DE, or nonresident working in DE**
- **Reasonable need for commission**
- **Good character and reputation; no felony convictions unless rights have been restored; no conviction involving dishonesty or moral turpitude**

Step 2

I purchased my state-required Notary seal and supplies at www.NationalNotary.org/DE/Become or I called 1-800-876-6827.

Step 3

I have received the supplies that are not dependent upon my commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc.).

Step 4

I have submitted my application at <https://notary.delaware.gov/apply-notary-commission/>

Step 5

I have received my commission certificate from the state.

Step 6

Within 30 days, I have printed out and taken my commission certificate to the recorder of deeds in the county where I live for recording.

New Castle County residents must also register with the Prothro Notary's Office.

Step 7

I have emailed or faxed a copy of my commission certificate with my NNA Customer ID number to: Releasing@nationalnotary.org or via fax to 1-800-833-1211. Once my documents have been received, my stamp will be shipped within 3 business days.

Step 8

I have received my seal stamp and insurance.
