



Iowa Notary Commission Process

Step-by-Step Instructions to Begin My Notary Commission

☐ Step 1

I am eligible to become a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements:

- Be at least 18 years old
- Be a citizen or permanent legal resident of the U.S.
- IA resident; non-resident of adjoining state if place of business is in IA
- Must be able to read/write English
- No voting disqualification due to felony conviction or judged mentally incompetent

☐ Step 2

I purchased my state-required Notary stamp and supplies at <u>NationalNotary.org/IA/Become</u> or call 1-800-876-6827. The NNA® will immediately ship the supplies that are not dependent upon the commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc., as requested).

☐ Step 3

I have completed my online Notary commission application.

☐ Step 4

The state issued and mailed my commission certificate.

☐ Step 5

I have emailed or faxed a copy of my commission certificate with my NNA Customer ID number to: Releasing@NationalNotary.org or via fax to 1-800-833-1211. Once my documents were received, my stamp was shipped within 3-5 business days.

NOTE: Any <u>lowa Notary package</u> you purchase from the NNA will include your state required item: Notary stamp. It's the best and most convenient way to make sure you have everything you need to become an lowa Notary.
