#### ☐ Step 1

I am eligible to become a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements:

- 18 years or older
- U.S. citizen or ID permanent resident; nonresident employed in ID
- Able to read and write English
- Never removed from office for misconduct or convicted of serious crime in the last 10 years

# ☐ Step 2

I purchased my state-required Notary seal and supplies at <a href="www.NationalNotary.org/ID/Become">www.NationalNotary.org/ID/Become</a> or called 1-800-876-6827 and provided my county.

# ☐ Step 3

I have received the supplies that are not dependent upon my commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc.).

#### ☐ Step 4

I have received my notary bond via email to submit with my application.

# ☐ Step 5

I completed my commission application online: https://sosbiz.idaho.gov/auth?from=/forms/new/384

# □ Step 6

I have received my commission certificate from the state, approximately 5-7 business days after submitting my application.

# ☐ Step 7

In order to receive my stamp, I have emailed a copy of my commission certificate to Releasing@NationalNotary.org or faxed a copy to 1-800-833-1211.

# ☐ Step 8

Once my documents have been received, my stamp will be shipped within 3 business days.
