



Idaho Notary Commission Process

Step-by-Step Instructions to Begin My Notary Commission

□ Step 1

I am eligible to become a Notary and a m in compliance with state requirements:

- 18 years or older
- U.S. citizen or permanent legal resident
- Resident of Idaho or employed in Idaho
- Able to read and write English

□ Step 2

I purchased my state-required Notary seal and supplies at <u>NationalNotary.org/ID/Become</u> or called 1-800-876-6827 and provided my county.

□ Step 3

I have received the supplies that are not dependent upon my commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc.).

□ Step 4

I have received my notary bond via email to submit with my application.

□ Step 5

I completed my commission <u>application online</u> including the state filing fee.

□ Step 6

I have received my commission certificate from the state.

□ Step 7

I have emailed or faxed a copy of my commission certificate with my NNA Customer ID number to: <u>Releasing@NationalNotary.org</u> or via fax to 1-800-833-1211. Once my documents have been received, my stamp will be shipped within 3-5 business days.

NOTE: Any <u>Idaho Notary package</u> you purchase from the NNA will include your state required item: Notary bond, and seal. It's the best and most convenient way to make sure you have everything you need to become an Idaho Notary.
