Step 1

I am eligible to become a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements:

- 18 years or older
- State-at-large commission: must be a Kentucky resident living or employed in county in which application is made or a non-resident of Kentucky and principally employed in county in which application is made
- Special commission: resident of county in which application is made or a non-resident of Kentucky
- Read, write and understand English
- Am of good moral character
- No felony convictions unless civil rights have been restored
- Am capable of performing duties of Notary

Step 2

I purchased my state-required Notary seal and supplies at www.NationalNotary.org/KY/Become or I called 1-800-876-6827.

Step 3

I have received the supplies that are not dependent upon my commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc.).

Step 4

I completed my commission application

Step 5

I have received my commission certificate from the state.

Step 6

I have sent a copy of my commission certificate to the NNA to issue my bond:

Step 7

Within 30 days, I have gone to the county clerk's office (listed on my postcard) and taken my oath of office, posted my bond, and recorded my appointment date.

Step 8

I have sent a copy of my commission certificate to the NNA: Releasing@nationalnotary.org, or faxed to 1-800-833-1211. Once my documents have been received, my stamp will be shipped within 3 business days.

Step 9

I have received my seal stamp.
