☐ Step 1

I am eligible to become a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements:

- 19 years or older
- NE resident; nonresident with a place of employment in NE
- Able to read and write English
- Not have been convicted of a felony or a crime involving fraud or dishonesty within the previous five years

☐ Step 2

I purchased my state-required Notary seal and supplies at www.NationalNotary.org/NE/Become or I called 1-800-876-6827 and have provided the NNA with my county.

Step 3

I have received the supplies that are not dependent upon my commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc.).

☐ Step 4

I have received my bond by email within two days after placing my order.

☐ Step 5

I completed my commission application and sent it, along with my bond and commission fee, to:

☐ Step 6

I have received the take-home test by email or mail from the Secretary of State's office. If I do not pass the test, I must wait 30 days before submitting a new application and fee.

☐ Step 7

I have received my commission certificate from the state.

☐ Step 8

I have emailed a copy of my certificate to Releasing@NationalNotary.org, or faxed it to 1-800-833-1211.

☐ Step 9

Once my documents have been received by the NNA, they will ship my stamp within 3 business days.
