



# **Nebraska Notary Commission Process**

Step-by-Step Instructions to Begin My Notary Commission

## Step 1

I am eligible to become a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements:

- 19 years or older
- Citizen of the Unites States or a qualified alien
- NE resident; resident of a bordering state with a place of employment in NE
- Not have been convicted of a felony or a crime involving fraud or dishonesty within the previous five years

#### **Step 2**

I purchased my state-required Notary bond, seal and supplies at <u>NationalNotary.org/NE/Become</u> or I called 1-800-876-6827 and have provided the NNA with my county.

## □ Step 3

I have received the supplies that are not dependent upon my commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc.).

## □ Step 4

I have reviewed the duties and obligations under Notary Statutes, Frequently Asked Questions, and Rules and Regulations on the <u>Nebraska SOS website</u> to assist with preparing for the exam.

## □ Step 5

I have taken my Nebraska Notary Exam online and passed with a score of 85% or more.

## □ Step 6

I have received my bond via email within two days after placing my order.

## Step 7

I completed my <u>commission application</u> and uploaded my bond and exam certificate and paid the state's filling fee.

## □ Step 8

I have received an email from the state notifying me that my commission was approved, and I logged into the state's <u>portal</u> to download my new Commission Certificate.

## □ Step 9

I have emailed a copy of my certificate to <u>Releasing@NationalNotary.org</u>, or faxed it to 1-800-833-1211. Once my documents have been received by the NNA, they will ship my stamp within 3-5 business days.





NOTE: Any <u>Nebraska Notary package</u> you purchase from the NNA will include your state required items: Notary bond and stamp. It's the best and most convenient way to make sure you have everything you need to become a Nebraska Notary.
