



New Jersey Notary Commission Process

Step-by-Step Instructions to Begin My Notary Commission

Step 1

I am eligible to become a Notary and in compliance with state requirements:

- Be at least 18 years old
- New Jersey resident or NJ-based company employee
- Not been convicted for any crimes of dishonesty

□ Step 2

I purchased my state-required Notary seal, Notary journal and supplies at <u>NationalNotary.org/NJ/Become</u> or called 1-800-876-6827.

□ Step 3

I have reviewed the <u>NJ Notary Public Manual</u> and watched the entire series of <u>Notary Public</u> <u>Manual Training Videos</u>

□ Step 4

I took and passed the <u>Notary Public Exam</u> online and received a Notary Exam Access Key in the confirmation email sent by the state, which is required for the online application.

□ Step 5

I have completed my Notary commission application online.

□ Step 6

I have received my supplies that are not dependent upon my commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc.).

Step 7

I have received my Notary Commission Packet from the Secretary of State.

□ Step 8

I have emailed a copy of my commission certificate with my NNA Customer ID number to: <u>Releasing@NationalNotary.org</u> or via fax to 1-800-833-1211 and my stamp will be shipped within 3-5 business days.

Step 9

I took my Notary Commission Packet to the county clerk's office, where the clerk administered my oath of office, and I paid the filling fee.

NOTE: Any <u>New Jersey Notary package</u> you purchase from the NNA will include your state required item: Notary Journal and Notary Stamp. It's the best and most convenient way to make sure you have everything you need to become a New Jersey Notary.
