☐ Step 1

I am eligible to become a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements:

- Be at least 18 years old
- NJ resident; non-resident or remote OK if employed in NJ
- No convictions for crime of dishonesty, or crime of first or second degree

☐ Step 2

Purchase NNA® Become a Notary supply package at <u>NationalNotary.org/NJ/Become</u> or call 1-800-876-6827. The NNA® will immediately ship the supplies that are not dependent upon the commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc. as requested).

☐ Step 3

Complete state-required training and exam.

☐ Step 4

Complete commission application online at https://www.njportal.com/DOR/Notary.

☐ Step 5

State issues my commission (approximately 2-10 weeks of turnaround).

☐ Step 6

I will scan and email a copy of my commission certificate to Releasing@NationalNotary.org or fax to 1-800-833-1211. Include my NNA Customer ID. Once my documents have been received, my stamp will be shipped within 3 business days.

☐ Step 7

Record my commission with the county clerk within 3 months of receipt of my commission certificate.
