



Ohio Notary Commission Process

Step-by-Step Instructions to Begin My Notary Commission

☐ Step 1

I am eligible to become a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements:

- 18 years or older;
- Resident of Ohio or a non-resident attorney practicing law in Ohio and maintains a primary place of business in the state;
- I have not been charged with a disqualifying offense.

☐ Step 2

I completed the criminal records check through an authorized agent within 6 months of applying: Ohio Attorney General's website

The BCI report must list 147.022 as the reason code.

☐ Step 3

I have purchased the 3-hour state-required training at NationalNotary.org/Ohio/become or I called 1-800-876-6827, and passed the exam.

☐ Step 4

I have created a user account on the <u>Secretary of State's website</u> and completed my application online.

☐ Step 5

I uploaded a copy of my criminal records check, certificates of completion for my course and exam, and an image of my signature, along with an application filing fee of \$15.

Step 6

I have received my commission certificate from the Secretary of State and followed the instructions for taking my oath of office in person.

☐ Step 7

I received my Notary seal stamp and E&O insurance policy (if purchased). If not, I have emailed a copy of my commission certificate with my NNA customer ID number to Releasing@NationalNotary.org or fax to 1-800- 833-1211.

NOTE: Any <u>Ohio Notary package</u> you purchase from the NNA will include all of your state required items: State-required New Notary Education and Exam, and Notary stamp. It's the best and most convenient way to make sure you have everything you need to become an Ohio Notary.
