



# Ohio Notary Commission Process

## Step-by-Step Instructions to Begin My Notary Commission

### ❑ Step 1

I am eligible to become a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements:

- 18 years or older;
- Resident of Ohio or a non-resident attorney practicing law in Ohio and maintains a primary place of business in the state;
- I have not been charged with a disqualifying offense.

### ❑ Step 2

I completed the criminal records check through an authorized agent within 6 months of applying: [Ohio Attorney General's website](#)

*The BCI report must list 147.022 as the reason code.*

### ❑ Step 3

I have purchased the 3-hour state-required training at [NationalNotary.org/Ohio/become](#) or I called 1-800-876-6827, and passed the exam.

### ❑ Step 4

I have created a user account on the [Secretary of State's website](#) and completed my application online.

### ❑ Step 5

I uploaded a copy of my criminal records check, certificates of completion for my course and exam, and an image of my signature, along with an application filing fee of \$15.

### ❑ Step 6

Once I have been notified by the state of the approval of my commission, I will email a copy of my commission certificate to [Releasing@NationalNotary.org](mailto:Releasing@NationalNotary.org) or fax to 1-800- 833-1211.

### ❑ Step 7

Once my documents have been received, my stamp will be shipped within 3-5 business days.

NOTE: Any [Ohio Notary package](#) you purchase from the NNA will include all of your state required items: State-required New Notary Education and Exam, and Notary stamp. It's the best and most convenient way to make sure you have everything you need to become an Ohio Notary.
