



Oklahoma Notary Commission Process

Step-by-Step Instructions to Begin My Notary Commission

Step 1

I am eligible to become a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements:

- 18 years or older;
- Am a citizen or permanent legal resident of the United States, and a resident of Oklahoma or a nonresident employed in the state;
- Ability to read and write in English;
- I have not been convicted of a felony or a crime involving fraud dishonesty, or deceit.

Step 2

I purchased my state required Notary seal and supplies at <u>NationalNotary.org/OK/Become</u> or I called 1-800-876-6827.

□ Step 3

I have received the supplies that are not dependent upon my commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc.).

Step 4

I have completed my <u>application online</u> and paid my \$25 fee to the Secretary of State.

□ Step 5

Upon approval of my application, the state will send me a copy of my commission certificate, a Notary Guide, and a blank surety bond form.

□ Step 6

I have received my commission certificate from the state. I have scanned and emailed a copy of my commission certificate to <u>Releasing@NationalNotary.org</u> or faxed it to 1-800-833-1211 to have my Notary seal made. Once my documents have been received, my stamp will be shipped within 3-5 business days.

□ Step 7

I have taken my bond form and stamp to a current Oklahoma Notary. They have administered my loyalty oath, my oath of office, watched me add my official signature and seal impression, and completed all three of the required notarizations.

□ Step 8

I have completed my bond form and sent it to the Secretary of State along with my \$10 filing fee.
