



Oregon Notary Commission Process

Step-by-Step Instructions to Begin My Notary Commission

☐ Step 1

I am eligible to become a Notary in Oregon and I am in compliance with state requirements:

- Be at least 18 years old.
- Reside in OR; non-resident OK if employed in OR.
- Must be able to read/write English.
- Good moral character.
- No felony or lesser convictions incompatible with duties of Notary in 10 years; no Notary commission revocation in 10 years.

☐ Step 2

Purchase my state-required seal and supplies at <u>NationalNotary.org/OR/Become</u> or call 1-800-876-6827. The NNA® will immediately ship the supplies that are not dependent upon the commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc., as requested).

☐ Step 3

I have taken my training from the NNA or an approved vendor on the Secretary of State's website.

☐ Step 4

I have taken the exam and completed my Notary commission application.

☐ Step 5

Once my application is accepted, I have taken my Oath of Office before a Notary, and sent a notarized copy to the state, along with the applicable \$40 processing fee.

☐ Step 6

Once my Certificate of Authorization has arrived from the state, I have emailed a copy to Releasing@NationalNotary.org, or faxed it to 1-800-833-1211, along with my NNA customer number and order number. Once my documents have been received, my stamp will be shipped within 3-5 business days.

NOTE: Any <u>Oregon Notary package</u> you purchase from the NNA will include your state required items: Notary training, stamp and journal. It's the best and most convenient way to make sure you have everything you need to become an Oregon Notary.
