#### ☐ Step 1

I am eligible to become a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements:

- 18 years or older
- A registered voter
- Read and write English

#### ☐ Step 2

I purchased my state-required Notary seal and supplies at <a href="www.NationalNotary.org/SC/Become">www.NationalNotary.org/SC/Become</a> or I called 1-800-876-6827.

#### Step 3

I have received the supplies that are not dependent upon my commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc.).

#### ☐ Step 4

I completed my commission application <a href="http://www.sos.sc.gov/forms/Notary/">http://www.sos.sc.gov/forms/Notary/</a> NP Application.pdf and sent it to my County Delegation office (counties listed on application instructions) along with the application fee.

## ☐ Step 5

I have received my commission certificate from the state.

#### ☐ Step 6

I have emailed a copy of my commission certificate to Releasing@NationalNotary.org or faxed a copy to 1-800-833-1211. Once my documents have been received, my stamp will be shipped within 3 business days.

#### ☐ Step 7

I have received my stamp.

### ☐ Step 8

Within 15 days, I have registered my commission with the local county clerk.
