☐ Step 1

I am eligible to become a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements:

- 18 years or older
- A VT resident, or have a place of employment or practice in VT
- Be a citizen or permanent legal resident of the U.S.

☐ Step 2

I purchased my Notary seal and supplies at www.NationalNotary.org/VT/Become or I called 1-800-876-6827.

☐ Step 3

I have received the supplies that are not dependent upon my commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc.).

☐ Step 4

I have completed the required exam.

☐ Step 5

I have completed and signed my Oath of Office form and had it notarized.

☐ Step 6

I have completed my application online at https://sos.vermont.gov/notaries-public/forms-instructions/ and paid the non-refundable application fee.

☐ Step 7

I have received my commission certificate from the state.

Step 8

I have emailed a copy of my commission certificate to Releasing@NationalNotary.org, or faxed it to 1-800-833-1211. Once my documents have been received, my stamp will be shipped within 3 business days.

☐ Step 9

I have received my stamp.
