



Wyoming Notary Commission Process

Step-by-Step Instructions to Begin My Notary Commission

☐ Step 1

I am eligible to become a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements:

- 18 years or older
- WY resident or have a place of employment or practice in the state or be the spouse or legal dependent of military personnel assigned to active duty in WY
- Able to read and write English
- No felony convictions unless reversed, annulled, pardoned, or all civil rights have been restored

☐ Step 2

I purchased my state required Notary seal and supplies at NationalNotary.org/WY/Become or I called 1-800-876-6827.

☐ Step 3

I have received the supplies that are not dependent upon my commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc.).

☐ Step 4

I have downloaded the application with exam pdf from the Wyoming SOS website.

☐ Step 5

I have reviewed the <u>Notary Education Presentation</u> which will help me answer the exam questions found on the application.

Note: If I have completed the state-required education and exam provide by the NNA, I will include the certificate of completion when submitting my application and skip to Part III of the application)

☐ Step 6

I have mailed my completed my application and my \$60 filling fee to:

☐ Step 7

I have received my commission certificate and appointment letter via email.

☐ Step 8

I have emailed or faxed a copy of my commission certificate with my NNA Customer ID number to: Releasing@NationalNotary.org or via fax to 1-800-833-1211. Once my documents have been received, my stamp will be shipped within 3-5 business days.





NOTE: Any <u>Wyoming Notary package</u> you purchase from the NNA will include your state required items: State-required education and exam, Notary stamp and journal. It's the best and most convenient way to make sure you have everything you need to become a Wyoming Notary.
