



Arizona Notary Commission Renewal Process

Step-by-Step Instructions to Renew My Notary Commission

☐ Step 1

I am eligible to become a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements:

- 18 years or older
- Resident of AZ for tax purposes or citizen or legal permanent resident of the U.S.
- Must be able to read and write English
- Not be convicted of a felony unless civil right has been restored

☐ Step 2

I purchased my state required Notary seal and supplies at NationalNotary.org/AZ/Renew or I called 1-800-876-6827.

☐ Step 3

I have received my \$5,000 bond, and had it notarized.

☐ Step 4

I completed my application online at <u>Secretary of State's website</u>, printed and signed it, and submitted it with my notarized bond and a \$43 filing fee to the Secretary of State.

☐ Step 5

I have received my supplies that are not dependent upon my commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc.).

☐ Step 6

I have received my commission certificate from the state and have checked my name, county of residence and commission dates are correct to ensure my stamp is made accurately.

☐ Step 7

I have emailed a copy of my commission certificate with my NNA Customer ID number to: Releasing@NationalNotary.org or via fax to 1-800-833-1211.

☐ Step 8

Once my documents have been received, my stamp will be shipped within 3-5 business days.
