



Georgia Notary Commission Process

Step-by-Step Instructions to Renew My Notary Commission

□ Step 1

I am eligible to renew as a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements:

- 18 years or older
- U.S. resident or permanent resident alien
- Reside in the county where application is filed
- Have an operating telephone number
- Able to read and write English

□ Step 2

I purchased my state-required Notary seal and supplies at <u>NationalNotary.org/GA/Renew</u> or I called 1-800-876-6827.

□ Step 3

I have received my supplies that are not dependent upon my commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc.).

□ Step 4

I have completed the mandatory <u>training course</u> provided by GSCCCA and have received my training certificate of completion.

□ Step 5

I checked if my county allows me to complete the <u>notary application online</u>. If my county isn't listed on the <u>Superior Clerks' website</u>, I'll need to get the application from the Clerk of Superior Court in my county of residence.

□ Step 6

I have paid my state filing fee and taken my oath of office.

□ Step 7

I have received my Notary certificate of appointment from the clerks office.

□ Step 8

I have emailed a copy of my commission certificate with my NNA Customer ID number to: <u>Releasing@NationalNotary.org</u> or via fax to 1-800-833-1211.





□ Step 9

Once my documents have been received, my stamp will be shipped within 3-5 business days.

NOTE: Any <u>Georgia Notary package</u> you purchase from the NNA will include all of your state required items: Notary stamp. It's the best and most convenient way to make sure you have everything you need to renew as a Georgia Notary.
