



# **Iowa Notary Commission Process**

Step-by-Step Instructions to Renew My Notary Commission

# ☐ Step 1

I am eligible to renew as a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements:

- Be at least 18 years old
- IA resident; non-resident of adjoining state if place of business is in IA
- Must be able to read/write English
- No voting disqualification due to felony conviction or judged mentally incompetent

#### ☐ Step 2

I purchased my state-required Notary stamp and supplies at <u>NationalNotary.org/IA/Renew</u> or call 1-800-876-6827. The NNA<sup>®</sup> will immediately ship the supplies that are not dependent upon the commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc., as requested).

# ☐ Step 3

I have completed my online <u>application</u>.

#### ☐ Step 4

The state issued and mailed my commission certificate.

#### ☐ Step 5

I have emailed or faxed a copy of my commission certificate with my NNA Customer ID number to: <a href="mailto:Releasing@NationalNotary.org">Releasing@NationalNotary.org</a> or fax to 1-800-833-1211. Once my documents were received, my stamp was shipped within 3-5 business days.

NOTE: Any <u>lowa Notary package</u> you purchase from the NNA will include your state required item: Notary stamp. It's the best and most convenient way to make sure you have everything you need to renew as an lowa Notary.
