☐ Step 1

I am eligible to become a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements:

- 18 years or older
- U.S. citizen or ID permanent resident; nonresident employed in ID
- Able to read and write English
- Never removed from office for misconduct or convicted of serious crime in the last 10 years

# ☐ Step 2

I purchased my state-required Notary seal and supplies at <a href="www.NationalNotary.org/ID/Renew">www.NationalNotary.org/ID/Renew</a> or I called 1-800-876-6827.

# ☐ Step 3

I have received the supplies that are not dependent upon my commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc.).

#### ☐ Step 4

I have received my bond via email to submit with my application 90 days prior to my expiration date.

# ☐ Step 5

I completed my commission application online: https://sosbiz.idaho.gov/auth?from=/records/notary

#### ☐ Step 6

I have received my commission certificate from the state.

# ☐ Step 7

I have emailed a copy of my commission certificate to the NNA to activate optional errors & omissions insurance to: <a href="Releasing@nationalnotary.org">Releasing@nationalnotary.org</a> or via fax to 1-800-833-1211.Once my documents have been received, my stamp will be shipped within 3 business days.

# ☐ Step 8

I have received my seal stamp from the NNA and verified the name on my bond matches the name on my stamp.
