



Kansas Notary Commission Process

Step-by-Step Instructions to Renew My Notary Commission

Step 1

I am eligible to renew as a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements:

- 18 years or older
- U.S. citizen
- Resident of Kansas or a bordering state and are employed or conducts a business in Kansas
- Able to read and write English
- No felony convictions or license revocation

□ Step 2

I purchased my state-required Notary bond, journal, seal, and supplies at <u>NationalNotary.org/KS/Renew</u> or I called 1-800-876-6827.

□ Step 3

I have received the supplies that are not dependent upon my commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc.).

□ Step 4

I have received my application with the bond within 90 days before my expiration date.

□ Step 5

I have received my seal stamp and verified that the name on my bond matches the name on my stamp.

□ Step 6

I have had my application notarized.

Step 7

I completed my commission application and sent it with the fee to:

Kansas Secretary of State Memorial Hall, 1st Floor 120 S.W. 10th Ave Topeka, KS 66612

□ Step 8

I have received my Notary Certificate from the state.





Step 9

I have emailed or faxed a copy of my commission certificate with my NNA Customer ID number to: <u>Releasing@NationalNotary.org</u> or via fax to 1-800-833-1211. Once my documents have been received, any remaining items in the order will be shipped or emailed within 3-5 business days.

NOTE: Any <u>Kansas Notary package</u> you purchase from the NNA will include your state required items: Notary bond, stamp and journal. It's the best and most convenient way to make sure you have everything you need to renew as a Kansas Notary.
