☐ Step 1

I am eligible to become a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements:

- Be at least 18 years old
- Resident of Massachusetts, or regularly conduct business in the state
- Read and write English

☐ Step 2

I have purchased an NNA® Become a Notary supply package at NationalNotary.org/MA/Renew or called 1-800-876-6827 to place my order.

■ Step 3

The NNA® will immediately ship the supplies that are not dependent upon the commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc., as requested).

☐ Step 4

I have completed my application (received in the mail or use this link: https://www.nationalnotary.org/file%20library/nna/applications/massachusetts_state-application--e-.pdf) and mailed it along with a copy of my up-to-date resume business card (if I have one) and mail to:

☐ Step 5

I have received my commission letter from the Secretary of the Commonwealth with directions to get sworn in.

☐ Step 6

I have been sworn in and paid the fee.

☐ Step 7

I will scan and email a copy of my commission letter to <u>Releasing@NationalNotary.org</u> or fax it to 1-800-833-1211 to have my Notary stamp made. Once my documents have been received, my stamp will be shipped within 3 business days.
