❑ Step 1

I am eligible to become a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements:

- **18 years or older;**
- **Am a resident of MN, IA, ND, SD or WI;**
- **Have not had a Notary commission revoked.**

❑ Step 2

I purchased my state-required Notary seal and supplies at www.NationalNotary.org/MN/Renew or I called 1-800-876-6827.

❑ Step 3

I have received the supplies that are not dependent upon my commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc.).

❑ Step 4

I have completed my application at <http://www.sos.state.mn.us/notary-apostille/> If I missed the deadline to renew, I filled out my application (www.NationalNotary.org/file%20library/nna/applications/minnesota_state-application--e-.pdf), checked "Reappointment" and submitted it by mail.

❑ Step 5

If I am mailing in my application, I have sent it (along with the fee payment) to:

❑ Step 6

I have received my commission from the state. Once my documents have been received, my stamp will be shipped within 3 business days.

If I need my new seal immediately, I will email a copy of my commission certificate (with a cover sheet that includes my Customer ID) to Customer Service at Releasing@NationalNotary.org or send via fax to 1-800-833-1211.

❑ Step 7

I have recorded my official commission and registered my official signature with the appropriate county office listed on my commission certificate. If I am registering by mail, I have had it notarized and paid applicable fees.
