



Minnesota Notary Commission Process

Step-by-Step Instructions to Renew My Notary Commission

☐ **Step 1**

I am eligible to renew as a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements:

- **18 years or older**
- **Am a resident of MN, IA, ND, SD or WI**
- **Have not had a Notary commission revoked**

☐ **Step 2**

I purchased my state-required Notary seal and supplies at NationalNotary.org/MN/Renew or I called 1-800-876-6827.

☐ **Step 3**

I have received the supplies that are not dependent upon my commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc.).

☐ **Step 4**

I have completed my [Notary renewal application](#). If I missed the deadline to renew, I filled out my Notary [application](#) checked "Reappointment" and submitted it by mail.

☐ **Step 5**

If I am mailing in my application, I have sent it (along with the \$120 fee payment) to:

☐ **Step 6**

My application was approved by the Secretary of State, and they have mailed my commission certificate along with instructions on where to register my commission.

☐ **Step 7**

I have emailed or faxed a copy of my commission certificate with my NNA Customer ID number to: Releasing@NationalNotary.org or via fax to 1-800-833-1211. Once my documents have been received, my stamp will be shipped within 3-5 business days.

☐ **Step 8**

I have followed the instructions on my commission certificate to record my official commission and register my official signature with the appropriate county office.

NOTE: Any [Minnesota Notary package](#) you purchase from the NNA will include your state required item: Notary stamp. It's the best and most convenient way to make sure you have everything you need to renew as a Minnesota Notary.
