



Mississippi Notary Commission Process

Step-by-Step Instructions to Renew My Notary Commission

Step 1

I am eligible to renew as a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements:

- 18 years or older
- U.S. citizen or permanent resident alien
- Reside in MS for a minimum of 30 days
- Able to read and write English
- No felony convictions unless pardoned or voting rights restored; not currently on probation or parole
- No commission revocation, suspension or restriction

□ Step 2

I purchased my state-required Notary seal and supplies at <u>NationalNotary.org/MS/Renew</u> or I called 1-800-876-6827.

□ Step 3

I have received the supplies that are not dependent upon my commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc.).

□ Step 4

Within 60-90 days before my expiration date, I completed and submitted my <u>Notary commission</u> application and sent it to:

Secretary of State Business Services Division P.O. Box 136 Jackson, MS 39205-0136

□ Step 5

I have received my pre-commission certificate from the state.

□ Step 6

I have emailed a copy of my pre-commission certificate to the NNA to issue my bond: <u>Releasing@NationalNotary.org</u>, or faxed to 1-800-833-1211.

□ Step 7

I have completed my Notary bond and oath and returned it to:

Secretary of State Business Services Division P.O. Box 136 Jackson, MS 39205-0136





□ Step 8

I have emailed or faxed a copy of my commission certificate with my NNA Customer ID number to: <u>Releasing@NationalNotary.org</u> or via fax to 1-800-833-1211. Once my documents have been received, my stamp will be shipped within 3-5 business days.

NOTE: Any <u>Mississippi Notary package</u> you purchase from the NNA will include your state required items: Notary bond, stamp and journal. It's the best and most convenient way to make sure you have everything you need to renew as a Mississippi Notary.
