



Nebraska Notary Commission Process

Step-by-Step Instructions to Renew My Notary Commission

Step 1

I am eligible to become a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements:

- **19 years or older**
- **NE resident; nonresident with a place of employment in NE**
- **Able to read and write English**
- **Not have been convicted of a felony or a crime involving fraud or dishonesty within the previous five years**

Step 2

I purchased my state-required Notary seal and supplies at NationalNotary.org/NE/Renew or I called 1-800-876-6827 and have provided the NNA with my county.

Step 3

I have received the supplies that are not dependent upon my commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc.).

Step 4

I have received my bond via email 60 days prior to my expiration date.

Step 5

Within 30 days of my commission expiration, I completed my [renewal application](#) and sent it, along with my bond, U.S. Citizenship Attestation Form and commission fee, to:

Step 6

I have received my commission certificate from the state.

Step 7

I have emailed a copy of my certificate to Releasing@NationalNotary.org, or faxed it to 1-800-833-1211. Once my documents have been received by the NNA, they will ship my stamp within 3-5 business days.
