



Nebraska Notary Commission Process

Step-by-Step Instructions to Renew My Notary Commission

☐ Step 1

I am eligible to renew as a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements:

- 19 years or older
- Citizen of the Unites States or a qualified alien
- NE resident; resident of a bordering state with a place of employment in NE
- Not have been convicted of a felony or a crime involving fraud or dishonesty within the previous five years

☐ Step 2

I purchased my state-required Notary bond, seal and supplies at <u>NationalNotary.org/NE/Renew</u> or I called 1-800-876-6827 and have provided the NNA with my county.

☐ Step 3

I have received the supplies that are not dependent upon my commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc.).

☐ Step 4

I have received my bond via email 90 days prior to my expiration date.

☐ Step 5

Within 30 days of my commission expiration, I went to the <u>Secretary of State's Online Notary Portal</u> and login to my account to complete my application, upload my bond and pay the state's filing fee.

☐ Step 6

I have received an email from the state notifying me that my commission was renewed, and I logged into the state's <u>portal</u> to download my new Commission Certificate.

□ Step 7

I have emailed a copy of my certificate to <u>Releasing@NationalNotary.org</u>, or faxed it to 1-800-833-1211. Once my documents have been received by the NNA, they will ship my stamp within 3-5 business days.

NOTE: Any <u>Nebraska Notary package</u> you purchase from the NNA will include your state required items: Notary bond and stamp. It's the best and most convenient way to make sure you have everything you need to renew as a Nebraska Notary.
