



New Jersey Notary Commission Process

Step-by-Step Instructions to Renew My Notary Commission

Step 1

I am eligible to renew as a Notary and in compliance with state requirements:

- Be at least 18 years old
- New Jersey resident or NJ-based company employee
- Not been convicted for any crimes of dishonesty

□ Step 2

I purchased my state-required Notary stamp, Notary journal and supplies at <u>NationalNotary.org/NJ/Renew</u> or called 1-800-876-6827.

□ Step 3

I have completed my continuing education course of study* (3-hours per the <u>NJ Notary Public</u> <u>Manual</u>, page 8).

*Note: Exam is NOT required renewing Notaries unless your commission has been expired for more than 30 days.

□ Step 4

I have completed my Notary commission application online.

□ Step 5

I have received my supplies that are not dependent upon my commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc.).

□ Step 6

I have received my Notary Commission Packet from the Secretary of State.

Step 7

I have emailed a copy of my commission certificate with my NNA Customer ID number to: <u>Releasing@NationalNotary.org</u> or via fax to 1-800-833-1211 and my stamp will be shipped within 3-5 business days.

Step 8

I took my Notary Commission Packet to the county clerk's office, where the clerk administered my oath of office, and I paid the filling fee.





NOTE: Any <u>New Jersey Notary package</u> you purchase from the NNA will include all of your state required items: Notary stamp and Notary journal. It's the best and most convenient way to make sure you have everything you need to renew as a New Jersey Notary.
