



Nevada Notary Commission Process

Step-by-Step Instructions to Renew My Notary Commission

□ Step 1

I am eligible to renew as a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements:

- 18 years or older
- Resident of NV or bordering state if employed in NV.
- If a convicted felon, civil rights have been restored.
- Have never had you Notary commission revoked in another state
- Possess civil rights (convicted felons whose civil rights have not been restored cannot become a Notary)
- Cannot hold a public office in the U.S. federal government at the time of application

□ Step 2

I purchased my state-required Notary bond, seal and supplies at <u>NationalNotary.org/NV/Renew</u> or call 1-800-876-6827. The NNA will immediately ship the supplies that are not dependent upon the commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc., as requested).

□ Step 3

I completed the three-hour online Notary training course through the <u>Secretary of State's Notary</u> <u>Division</u> and passed the exam.

Step 4

I filed my Notary bond and oath of office with the county clerk. They issued a filing notice, which I included in my application.

□ Step 5

I submitted my application, filing notice, training and exam certificate and state filing fee, to the Secretary of State via the <u>SilverFlume online portal</u>.

□ Step 6

After I received my commission certificate from the state, I mailed either the original or a certified copy to:

Step 7

After the NNA received my documents, they shipped my stamp within 3 business days and returned my original commission certificate with the seal.

NOTE: Any <u>Nevada Notary package</u> you purchase from the NNA will include your state required items: Notary bond, Notary journal and Notary Stamp. It's the best and most convenient way to make sure you have everything you need to renew as a Nevada Notary.
