Step 1

I am eligible to become a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements:

- 18 years or older;
- Resident of Ohio or am an attorney licensed to practice law in Ohio and maintains a primary place of business in the state;
- I am of good moral character;
- I have not been charged with a disqualifying offense.

Step 2

I have completed the criminal records check through an authorized agent within 6 months of applying:

Step 3

I have purchased the 1-hour state-required training at www.NationalNotary.org/OH/Renew or I called 1-800-876-6827.

Step 4

I have submitted my application online at <https://notary.ohiosos.gov/>.

You will be required to upload a copy of your criminal records check, certificates of completion for your course, and an image of your signature, along with an application filing fee of \$15.

Step 5

Once I have been notified by the state of the approval of my commission, I will email a copy of my commission certificate to Releasing@NationalNotary.org or fax to 1-800-833-1211.

Step 6

Once my documents have been received, my stamp will be shipped within 3 business days.
