



# Ohio Notary Commission Renewal Process

## Step-by-Step Instructions to Renew My Notary Commission

### ❑ Step 1

I am eligible to renew as a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements:

- 18 years or older;
- Resident of Ohio or a non-resident attorney practicing law in Ohio and maintains a primary place of business in the state;
- I have not been charged with a disqualifying offense.

### ❑ Step 2

I completed the criminal records check through an authorized agent within 6 months of applying: [Ohio Attorney General's website](#)

*The BCI report must list 147.022 as the reason code.*

### ❑ Step 3

I have purchased the 1-hour state-required training at [NationalNotary.org/OH/Renew](#) or called 1-800-876-6827.

### ❑ Step 4

I have completed my application online at [Secretary of State's website](#).

### ❑ Step 5

I uploaded a copy of my criminal records check, certificates of completion for my course, and an image of my signature, along with an application filing fee of \$15.

### ❑ Step 6

I have received my commission certificate from the Secretary of State and followed the instructions for taking my oath of office in person.

### ❑ Step 7

I received my Notary seal stamp and E&O insurance policy (if purchased). If not, I have emailed a copy of my commission certificate with my NNA customer ID number to [Releasing@NationalNotary.org](mailto:Releasing@NationalNotary.org) or fax to 1-800- 833-1211.

NOTE: Any [Ohio Notary package](#) you purchase from the NNA will include all of your state required items: State-required Renew Notary Education, and Notary stamp. It's the best and most convenient way to make sure you have everything you need to renew as an Ohio Notary.
