I am eligible to become a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements:

- 18 years or older
- Citizen or permanent legal resident of the U.S.
- A resident of or have a place of employment or practice in Rhode Island
- Read and write English

☐ Step 2

I purchased my state-required Notary seal and supplies at www.NationalNotary.org/RI/Renew or I called 1-800-876-6827.

☐ Step 3

I have received the supplies that are not dependent upon my commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc.).

☐ Step 4

I took my Oath of Office on the application and had it notarized.

☐ Step 5

I completed my commission application https://www.sos.ri.gov/assets/downloads/documents/ Notary-Renewal-Application.pdf and sent with the fee to:

☐ Step 6

I have received my commission certificate from the state.

☐ Step 7

I have emailed a copy of my commission certificate to the NNA: Releasing@NationalNotary.org, or faxed to 1-800-833-1211. Once my documents have been received, my stamp will be shipped within 3 business days.

☐ Step 8

I have received my seal stamp.
