☐ Step 1

I am eligible to become a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements:

- 18 years or older
- A registered voter
- Read and write English

☐ Step 2

I purchased my state-required Notary seal and supplies at www.NationalNotary.org/SC/Renew or I called 1-800-876-6827.

☐ Step 3

I have received the supplies that are not dependent upon my commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc.).

☐ Step 4

I completed my commission application http://www.sos.sc.gov/forms/Notary/
NP Application.pdf and sent it to my County Delegation office (counties listed on application instructions) along with the application fee.

┙ Step 5

I have received my commission certificate from the state.

☐ Step 6

I have emailed a copy of my commission certificate to Releasing@NationalNotary.org, or faxed a copy to 1-800-833-1211. Once my document has been received, my stamp will be shipped within three business days.

☐ Step 7

I have received my seal stamp.

☐ Step 8

Within 15 days, I have registered my commission with the local county clerk.
