



South Dakota Notary Commission Process

Step-by-Step Instructions to Renew My Notary Commission

☐ Step 1

I am eligible to renew as a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements:

- 18 years or older
- A SD resident, or nonresident from a county bordering SD and working in state
- No felony convictions

☐ Step 2

I purchased my state-required Notary seal stamp and recommended supplies at NationalNotary.org/SD/Renew or I called 1-800-876-6827.

☐ Step 3

I have received the supplies I purchased in my Notary package from the NNA.

☐ Step 4

I completed my Notary commission application and sent it with my \$30 commission fee to:

Office of the Secretary of State Notary Public Division 500 East Capitol Avenue Pierre, SD 57501

☐ Step 6

I have received my commission certificate from the state.

NOTE: Any <u>South Dakota Notary package</u> you purchase from the NNA will include your state required item: stamp. It's the best and most convenient way to make sure you have everything you need to renew as a South Dakota Notary.
