Step 1 I am eligible to become a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements: 18 years or older A UT resident for at least 30 days, or non-residents OK if employed in UT for at least 30 days. Able to read and write English Endorsed by two Utah residents over 18
Step 2 I purchased my state-required Notary seal and supplies at www.NationalNotary.org/UT/ Become ,or I called 1-800-876-6827.
Step 3
I have received the supplies that are not dependent upon my commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc.)
Step 4
I have created an account, then taken and passed the mandatory state exam on the state's website: https://secure.utah.gov/account/log-in.html .
Step 5 I have contacted the NNA to let them know I have passed my exam and provided my county and commission dates to: Releasing@NationalNotary.org or 1-800-876-6827.
Step 6
I have received my bond via email.
Step 7 I have completed my background check.
Step 8 I completed my commission application online: https://secure.utah.gov/account/log-in.html
Step 9
I have received my Certificate of Authority of Notary Public from the state approximately two weeks after submitting my application
Step 10
I have emailed a copy of my notarized Certificate of Authority of Notary Public, including the

top portion with the oath, to the NNA: Releasing@NationalNotary.org, or faxed to
