



# **Virginia Notary Commission Process**

Step-by-Step Instructions to Renew My Notary Commission

# ☐ Step 1

I am eligible and am in compliance with state requirements:

- 18 years or older
- Legal resident of the U.S.
- Resident of Virginia or nonresidents employed in the state
- Read and write English
- No felony conviction in any state unless rights restored.

# ☐ Step 2

I purchased my state-required Notary seal and supplies at <u>NationalNotary.org/VA/Renew</u> or I called 1-800-876-6827.

## ☐ Step 3

I have received the supplies that are not dependent upon my commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc.).

### ☐ Step 4

I have printed and completed my Notary application using the application wizard on the <u>Virginia Secretary of the Commonwealth website</u>. I have had my signature on Part 3 of the application notarized.

# ☐ Step 5

I have mailed the completed, notarized application and application payment receipt to:

Office of the Secretary of the Commonwealth Notary Public Division P.O. Box 1795 Richmond, VA 23218-1795

I have received a digital copy of my new commission certificate.

# ☐ Step 7

I have scanned and emailed a copy of my commission certificate to <a href="Releasing@NationalNotary.org">Releasing@NationalNotary.org</a> or faxed it to 1-800-833-1211 to have my Notary seal made. Once my documents have been received, my stamp will be shipped within 3-5 business days.





NOTE: Any <u>Virginia Notary package</u> you purchase from the NNA will include your state required item: Notary seal. It's the best and most convenient way to make sure you have everything you need to renew as a Virginia Notary.
