

Montana Requirements to Perform Remote Online Notarizations

Step-by-step instructions for Notaries who plan to perform remote notarizations.

- 1. Be a Commissioned Montana Notary
 - Before applying to become a Montana RON, you must be commissioned as a traditional Notary Public in the state of Montana.
- 2. Choose a State-Approved RON Technology Provider

To perform remote notarizations, you'll need to choose a <u>RON technology provider</u> that meets Montana state requirements for virtual notarizations.

- 3. Complete a State-Approved Course and Receive Proof of Completion You'll need to take a state-approved course and pass an exam to receive a certificate of completion. The NNA offers a training course that satisfies this requirement.
- 4. Submit Your Notary Public Information Update and Exam Certificate

 Complete the Notary Public Information Update form and submit it, along with your exam certificate of completion, to the Montana Secretary of State's online portal.
