# **Notary/Signer Relationship**

The Notary:

- Screens for willingness and awareness
- Authenticates signer's identity
- Verifies signer's signature
- Compels signer to truthfulness

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## **5 Essential Steps**

- 1. Require personal appearance
- 2. Check document and certificate
- 3. Identify and screen signer
- 4. Complete journal entry
- 5. Fill in, sign, seal the certificate



#### The signer:

- Appears in front of Notary
- Identified by Notary
- "Acknowledges" having signed document

## Jurat or Verification on Oath

#### The signer:

- Appears in front of Notary
- Identified by Notary
- Signs document in front of Notary
- Swears to truthfulness of document



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## **Professional Practices**

- Use reasonable care
- Avoid unauthorized practice of law:
   \*DO NOT choose notarization
   \*DO NOT give advice
   \*DO NOT fill in document blanks
- Refer signers as appropriate



# **Scenario Directions**

- 1. Look over document and certificate
- 2. Check identification of signer(s)
- 3. Perform acknowledgment or jurat
- 4. Complete journal entry (charge \$X.00)
- 5. Complete certificate

Scenarios take place at your office:

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- Sarah Signer appears at your office with a Power of Attorney dated May 25, 2016, and asks you to notarize her signature on it.
- The document is complete except for Sarah's signature.
- It has Notary wording acceptable in your state.
- Sarah clearly is signing the document willingly and is aware of what's going on.
- Sarah presents her driver's license as ID.
- The address on the ID is current.



- Simon Signer arrives at your office with an insurance affidavit for items that were stolen from his house.
- The document is complete, except for Simon's signature, is dated today, and has certificate wording that is acceptable in your state.
- Simon clearly is signing willingly and is aware of what's going on.
- Simon presents his driver's license as ID.
- The address on the ID is current.







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- Claudia Pastorelli and Fred Fiance have a Prenuptial Agreement that they have both signed.
- The document is dated May 16, 2015, and has preprinted certificate wording that is acceptable in your state.
- Both have acceptable ID documents.
- Claudia's address is:

22 Elm Street Anytown, Anystate 44444






- Clint Sample asks you to notarize his letter of consent so his daughter can travel to Canada.
- Clint clearly is signing the document willingly and is aware of what's going on.
- For ID, Clint presents his driver's license that contains his current address.
- Clint says that he was told to sign the document in front of you and swear to it's truthfulness.








- Tammie Ang requests notarization of a Grant Deed for a property owned by her & her sister.
- You notice the document is dated February 23, 2004.
- It's complete except for two blank signature lines: one for Tammie & one for her sister, Ruby K. Ang, who is not here.
- The certificate is acceptable in your state, but you notice that the certificate says, "personally appeared Ruby K. Ang & Tammie Ang."
- Tammie presents her driver's license & clearly is signing willingly and is aware of what's going on.

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- Joe Sample brings a Durable Power of Attorney to you for notarization.
- Everything is in order.
- The document is dated a couple of days ago, it has certificate wording that's acceptable in your state, Joe's signature is original, he's willing and aware, his driver's license is correct.
- your state, Joe s signate.
  willing and aware, his driver's license is concer.
  You then notice the venue on the certificate says, "Idaho." That's where Joe had the POA drawn up, but you are NOT an Idaho Notary!
