BECOME A NOTARY In Florida

1. QUALIFICATIONS

To qualify in Florida, you must:

- Be 18 years old or older.
- Be a legal Florida resident.
- Not have felony convictions, unless your rights are restored.

2. REQUIREMENTS

If you qualify, your next steps are:

- Get your Notary surety bond from a bonding agency.
- Take a 3-hour training course.
- Submit an application, which includes your bond, affidavit of character and oath of office, via the bonding agency.

3. COMMISSION

If your application is approved, your bonding agency will send you your commission certificate.

4. SUPPLIES

You're required to have an official stamp.

Optional items to consider are a journal, a Notary Errors & Omissions insurance policy and a carry-case that locks.
