New Law Update

Law Changes Effective 1/1/14

- 1. Certificate wording Proofs of Execution
- 2. Prison inmate IDs
- 3. Price-gouging for immigration-related services
- Translating term "Notary Public" by nonattorneys
- 5. New penalties regarding livestock theft

1. AB 464 - Certificate Wording

- Proof of Execution by Subscribing Witness:
 - Before: "substantially similar" wording
 - After: "exact" wording

 Must use CA certificate even if the proof will be filed in another state

2. AB 625 - Prison Inmate IDs

- Inmate ID now acceptable if:
 - Issued by CDCR

Inmate is in custody at a facility operated by CDCR

Does not apply to inmate IDs at other facilities

3. AB 35 - Price-Gouging

Redundant: maximum fees already set

Forbids price-gouging for immigration services

SoS can deny, suspend or revoke commission for violations

4. AB 1159 - Translation

Misdemeanor for non-attorneys

Penalty: \$1,000 per day per violation

Immigration consultant bond increases
 July 1, 2014, from \$50,000 to \$100,000

5. AB 924 - Livestock Theft

SoS may deny, suspend or revoke Notary commission

 Punishable by imprisonment in county jail for up to one year
